

ICLA POINT SHOW RULES

REQUIREMENTS

- Exhibitor must be a paid ICLA member in order to collect Points & Premiums at ICLA Shows.
- Points for ALL NEW MEMBERS will not begin to accumulate until you become an paid ICLA member, so dues must be paid prior to a show to accumulate points for that show.
- Youth age requirements for showing are as follows: for ICLA Shows (Eureka) no minimum age requirement; all other shows not sponsored by ICLA (Moultrie-Douglas) age requirement dictated by their fair book; ICLA Market Ewe Show & Illinois Junior Wether Show requirement is 10 years old as stated in the Illinois State Fair Book.

SHOWS FOR 2009

Eureka ICLA Jack Pot Show = June 13th

Arthur M-D County Fair = July 11th

Market Ewe Show at Springfield = August 13th

Junior Wether Show at Illinois State Fair = August 14th

- **Because there are only 4 point shows there will be no minimum requirement of shows to attend this year. This is due to the minimum age requirement at the Illinois State Fair.**

BREEDS

- Breeds offered will be Hampshire, Suffolk, Crossbred, Natural, Dorset, & AOB.
- There must be 5 animals of an offered breed in order to have a class or they will be placed in the AOB class.

POINT ACCUMULATION

- Points will only be accumulated by members who are signed-up and have paid their dues.
- Only the points from an exhibitor's top 3 sheep at each show along with showmanship points, will count toward an individuals point total for that show. (Exhibitors are not limited to 3 sheep per show, but points will only be accumulated from the 3 highest point-accumulating sheep.
- Points are accumulated per exhibitor, not lamb. The exhibitor showing the lamb is the exhibitor accumulating the points, except if that exhibitor has 2 lambs that are in the same class.
- Showmanship participants must have lambs entered in the show in order to show in showmanship.

- Class Placing

1st Place = number of lambs in class x 6

2nd Place = number of lambs in class x 5

3rd Place = number of lambs in class x 4

4th Place = number of lambs in class x 3

5th Place = number of lambs in class x 2

、 6th Place to last place = number of lambs in class x 1

Breed Champion = 15 points

Reserve Breed Champion = 10 points

Grand Champion = 30 points

Reserve Champion = 20 points

Showmanship

Senior = 14-19 years

Junior = up to 13 years

Champion = 15 points

Reserve = 10 points

All Other Participants = 5 points
