

Jackpot Show Rules

1. **Open to all youth 9-21 years old as of 1/1/08.**
2. **All entry fees will be returned in Jackpot.**
3. Entry Fee: \$10.00 per animal. **(\$20.00 if registered after 6/01/08)**
4. Pen Fee: \$10.00 per pen **(\$15.00 if registered after 6/01/08)** – no more than two animals per pen. All animals must be penned in a CSCC provided pen.
5. Guaranteed prizes of \$125.00 for Grand Champion and \$100.00 for Reserve Champion for each species.
6. Total entry fees will determine prizes for individual classes.
7. The total number of animals entered per species will determine the number of classes and class sizes. Class size will not exceed 12 entries per class.
8. Classes will be determined by individual animal weight and the total number of animals entered per species.
9. All animals will be weighed by a CSCC representative immediately after unloading. The CSCC weight is final. Re-weighing animals will not be allowed.
10. The CSCC will provide penning for all animals. Exhibitors must provide their own wood sawdust or wood shavings bedding. Dried wood shavings will be available for purchase on site.
11. Judges and show facilities will be provided by the CSCC.
12. Facilities for penning animals overnight will not be available.
13. Only barrows and gilts will be allowed in hog classes. Sheep must exhibit lamb teeth.
14. All lambs must provide scrapie number.

The Central Summer Classic Committee (CSCC) reserves the right to assign classes, determine classes, adjust posted schedule, and judge prospect lambs and prospect pigs simultaneously in separate rings, or one species following the other in the same ring, depending on the number of entrants, weather conditions, and other Gratiot County Fairground commitments.

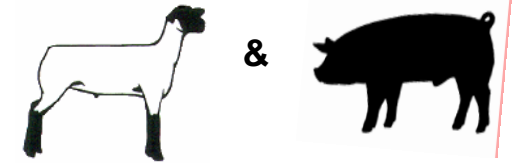
