General Rules

*This is a Lamb jackpot show open to any 4-H and FFA member between the ages of 9-21 as of January 1st, 2010.

*Exhibitors shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and good sportsmanship and reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to promote the advancement of agricultural education.

*Exhibitors are required to present and care for animals in a humane and ethical manner.

General Sheep Rules

1. All market lambs must be slick shorn within at least 5 days prior to weigh-in at this show.
2. Humane handling practices of sheep are required at all times.
3. Generators are allowed and recommended due to limited power.
4. With limited space showman are welcome to show off trailers.
5. Bedding will not be provided at the show.
6. Health Requirements- sheep with clinical signs of infectious, contagious, or toxicological disease will not be permitted to show and should not be unloaded at the show site. In addition, because of the USDA requirements for intra and/of interstate movement of sheep, all sheep must have official USDA identification (ID) ear tags.

Market Lamb Preview

1. Classes will be determined by weight on day of show. Classes will be divided with approximately equal numbers per class.
2. We will not offer a market ewe lamb class but will allow ewes to show with weathers by weight.
3. Weight class winners will be brought back to determine the division grand and reserve champions. The division grand and reserve champions will then be brought back for the overall grand and reserve champion placing.
4. Grand and Reserve champions will be awarded along with the top five over all market lambs.

Shepherds Quiz

1. The quiz will consist of multiple choice questions, where contestants will be tested on their general knowledge of market lambs. There will be three age divisions Junior (9-12), Intermediate (13-15), and Senior (16-21).

Late Entry

Any entry forms postmarked after May 1st, 2010 will be expected to pay late entry. Late Fees will be \$20/head.
