



CLUB LAMB PEN OF 3 SHOW & SALE

ENTRY FEE: \$65 PER ENTRY OF PEN OF THREE

SHOW & SALE RULES

1. All Club Lamb Pens must be weighed in and have mouths checked by **7 PM, Friday, February 27, 2009**.
2. Three (3) head of lambs will constitute a pen. Pens may include wethers, ewes, or a combination of wethers & ewes.
3. The entry fee for all club lamb pens includes entry for all three animals into Saturday's Jackpot Show. Youth exhibitors wishing to enter these lambs in the Sunday show will pay the normal entry fee with no late fee added. Only animals purchased by youth will be eligible to participate in the Jackpot Show. In the event that an animal does not sell, or the purchaser does not show in the Jackpot Show, entry fees will not be refunded but will be kept to offset awards costs for the youth.
4. Lamb pens will be sold in the following order: 1) Grand Champion Lamb, 2) Reserve Grand Champion Lamb, 3) Grand Champion Pen of Three, with the highest bidder selecting their choice of lamb(s), 4) Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three, etc.
5. There will be an 8% sales commission fee charged. Commission is based on the full price for the lamb, which includes all no-sale and buy back animals. The commission on the no-sale and buy back animals is due before animals will be released from the grounds. Commission on no sales and buy backs is the responsibility of consignor/exhibitor. All No Sale animals will be charged commission based on \$200 per animal.
6. Lamb Weight Limit: each individual lamb may not exceed 109 pounds. Lambs over the maximum weight will be sifted.
7. Lambs will be weighed once. This weight will be the classification and sale weight. After lambs are weighed they will be divided into three equal divisions; lightweight, middleweight and heavyweight. Each pen of 3 will be weighed and classified by the average weight of the 3 lambs in the pen. This weight will also determine the show weight for Jackpot Show.
8. All lambs entered must be in good sale condition and free of fungus, pinkeye, foot rot/scald and abscesses and must not be lame, nor blind. Lamb/milk teeth should be obvious.
9. All lambs entered must have a Scrapie tag.
10. Wonnell Auction Management reserves the right to appoint a competent person or persons to pass judgment on the quality of the animals entered and exhibited.

WETHER DAM SHOW & SALE

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER EWE ENTRY

SHOW & SALE RULES

1. All Wether Dams must be weighed in and have mouths checked by **7 PM, Friday, February 27, 2009**.
2. Ewes will be weighed once. This weight will be the classification and sale weight. After ewes are weighed class breaks will be determined by lambs or yearlings (based on teeth), then broken down into weight categories. If numbers permit there will be two yearling classes and a minimum of 3 lamb classes for ewe lambs.
3. The entry fee for all wether dam ewe lambs includes entry into Saturday's Jackpot Show. Youth exhibitors wishing to enter these ewe lambs in the Sunday show will pay the normal entry fee with no late fee added. Only animals purchased by youth will be eligible to participate in the Jackpot Show. In the event that an animal does not sell, or the purchaser does not show in the Jackpot Show, entry fees will not be refunded but will be kept to offset award costs for the youth.
4. Wether Dams will sell following the pens in the following order: 1) Supreme Champion Ewe, 2) Reserve Supreme Champion Ewe, 3&4) Remaining two Champion Wether Dams not selected as Supreme or Reserve Supreme, etc.
5. There will be a 8% sales commission fee charged. Commission is based on the full price for the ewe, which includes all no-sale and buy back animals. The commission on the no-sale and buy back animals is due before animals will be released from the grounds. Commission on no sales and buy backs is the responsibility of consignor/exhibitor. All No Sale animals will be charged commission based on \$200 per animal.
6. All ewes entered must be in good sale condition and free of fungus, pinkeye, foot rot/scald and abscesses and must not be lame, nor blind.
7. All ewes entered must have a Scrapie tag.
8. Wonnell Auction Management reserves the right to appoint a competent person or persons to pass judgment on the quality of the animals entered and exhibited.
